Current Hotel Supply

East Hampshire is served by a total of 11 hotels, with 355 bedrooms. The stock here comprises a mix of budget and small independent 3 star hotels split primarily between Alton, Petersfield and Liphook. New Premier Inn budget hotels opened in Petersfield in 2006 and Horndean in 2008. The Travelodge Alton Four Marks added 20 bedrooms in 2006. A further budget hotel is proposed in Petersfield. The Old Thorns at Liphook has plans to expand and upgrade to 4 star.
